

Paint a Western Front news rack!

Submit your design idea to the Western Front Advertising office:

Drop off at **Communication Facility 230** or email a PDF to Michele.anderson@wwu.edu. Include a sketch with notes (if needed). Include name, phone number, address, and email with submission.

Restrictions:

NO profanity, political statements, controversial topics, nudity, copyrighted material, or words other than the name of the publication and the artist's signature. The Western Front reserves any and all rights to refuse a design as submitted. The news racks are intended to be pleasing to a wide community audience, including children. The design must include **The Western Front**. The upper front viewing window must be clear.



If your idea is approved, pick up a news rack from **Communication 230**:

Dimensions are 42”H x 18”W x 14.5”D. We can help you load the rack into your vehicle. Rack weighs approximately 30 pounds. You can take up to four weeks to complete your design.

Materials/Costs:

We provide the rack. You provide the primer, paint, and sealer. Sand the rack lightly and use a metal primer. Exterior house paint or spray paint works best. The rack will be outdoors and subject to significant weather and possible vandalism, so pick materials appropriately. Finish with a washable, scrubbable exterior topcoat.

Racks will be placed in visible, high traffic locations in downtown Bellingham and Fairhaven. You'll be famous! (Or at least have something cool to show your parents when they visit.) News racks remain the property of The Western Front.
